### **Update on the review of pro-competitive conditions imposed on licensees in respect of the Call Termination Regulations**

**03 March 2017**

**Johannesburg** – The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (ICASA) would like to take the opportunity to thank all stakeholders who participated in the initial process to review the pro-competitive conditions imposed on licensees in terms of the Call Termination Regulations.

Following the publication of ICASA's intention to review the pro-competitive conditions, the Authority received letters from licensees requiring clarity in relation to the questionnaire published on 30 January 2017 while some of the questions related to the process to be undertaken thereof.

ICASA will respond to licensees' questions of clarity on the questionnaire in the form of a briefing note to be published on the website by the end of the week. ICASA has also noted concerns raised by licensees regarding the submission date of 28 February 2017 and has therefore decided to change the submission date to 24 March 2014.

In order to clarify the process in respect of the review of pro-competitive conditions, ICASA will host a stakeholder briefing session at its head office in Sandton on 15 March 2017 from 10h00 to 13h00.
