General Notice – Suspension of the effective date of the End-User and Subscriber Services Charter Amendment Regulations, 2018, Notice 233 of Government Gazette 41613 published on 07 May 2018

1. The End-User and Subscriber Services Charter Amendment Regulations, Notice 233 of Government Gazette 41613 (“the Amendment Regulations”) will no longer be effective as from 8 June 2018. The effective date is suspended pending the final determination of Part A of an urgent application launched by Cell C Limited in the High Court, Gauteng Local Division, Johannesburg.
2. The suspension of the effective date is consequent to a Court Order in terms of which the High Court, by agreement, ordered that, until Part A of the urgent application has been determined, the Authority will not take any steps to

implement the Amendment Regulations, nor will it take any action against Licensees for non-compliance with the Amendment Regulations.

3. The Authority will now file its answering affidavit responding to the application, and Cell C its replying affidavit, whereafter the application will be argued.
4. The Authority will continuously update Licensees on the developments in the dispute.
