- o Economic analysis of South African mobile broadband market (refer to recent Competition Authority findings on data pricing)
- o Need for increased Black ownership and competitive power in the industry
- o Challenges with current wholesale regime.

- o When will digital migration be completed and the 700 MHz and 800 MHz spectrum become available?
- o We agree with the proposal to require rural coverage before licensees are allowed to use the spectrum in urban areas
- o The WOAN Company should remain 100% Black owned for at least 20 years after receipt of the License and Spectrum.

In Conclusion our key demands are the following:

1. That the WOAN must be 100% Black Owned.
2. All High demand Spectrum must go to the WOAN.
3. All other spectrum that is available must be made available to the WOAN first.
4. We do not have site of the ITA even though it is mentioned in the IM.
5. We want access to the draft ITA to make comment before final issuing.
6. There are independent assurances put in place to ensure the success of the WOAN
