- The task team communicated with Cell C regarding the lack of progress and potential measures to be taken against it. Progress regarding negotiations between Switch Telecoms, MTN and Vodacom will be monitored.

Intercell Online Africa (Pty) Ltd 'IOLA' vs Telkom SA Limited

- The dispute was regarding interconnection agreement, where Telkom refused to interconnect.
- In view of the of response by the complainant, it was therefore recommended to Council that the matter be closed.

Village Operator (Pty) Ltd 'VO' vs Telkom SA Limited

- Interconnection Agreement Dispute – refusal by Telkom to interconnect on voice and data due to an alleged outstanding debt of R1 226 838.32 of another company with the same 100% shareholder as Village Operator.
- It was recommended to Council that the matter be closed.

Cell C vs Intercell Online Africa (Pty) Ltd 'IOLA'

- Cell C alleged manipulation of calling line identification by IOLA, which was in contravention of the Numbering Plan Regulations,

Draft Regulations on Unreserved Postal Services</p> <p>The purpose of the submission was to request Council to approve the draft regulations on Unreserved Postal Services for publication.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the 22 of March 2019, the Authority published a Position paper on the effectiveness of the regulations on Unreserved postal services. • It was the position of the Authority that the Regulations would be reviewed to address the ineffectiveness identified from the inquiry. • The review was informed by the Postal Services Act no.124 of 1998 in its current form. • Following the publication of the Draft Regulations, the Authority will hold public hearings to take into consideration inputs from stakeholders. 	<p>It was resolved that the draft regulations on Unreserved Postal Services be approved for publication.</p>
