ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AMENDMENT BILL

[B12 – 2026]

PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS

The Portfolio Committee on Communications and Digital Technologies invites stakeholders and interested parties to make written submissions on the **Electronic Communications Amendment Bill [B12 – 2026]**. **The Bill was tabled to Parliament by the Minister of Communications and Digital Technologies on 20 April 2026.**

The Bill seeks: to amend the Electronic Communications Act, 2005, so as to enable the Minister responsible for local government to make a national standard by-law on rapid deployment of electronic communications networks and facilities; to enable the “use it or share it” principle for spectrum; to regulate roaming and mobile virtual network operator services; to improve the facilities leasing framework and provide for wholesale pricing rules and standards; to provide for improved competition regulation; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

The closing date to make written submissions on the Bill is 16:00 on Friday, 21 August 2026. You are requested to indicate in your submission if you would like to make an oral presentation to the Committee.
